The tree in season

Sort instruments by timbre into groups to depict the four seasons

The tree in season composition

Compose and perform four seasons music

Global warming

Learn to sing a song in a minor key

Global warming accompaniments

Accompany the song Global warming with a drone and ostinato

Global warming sounds

Select different timbres to accompany the song

Check that the children listen carefully as they add their descriptive global warming sounds to the song; ensure that they complement the lyrics, and balance the volume of the voices appropriately.
